- Good for the baby nantes and bunching market
- Very good root quality



DESCRIPTION

PLANT

- Very good tolerance to bolting
- Healthy, upright habit
- Strong attachment, good aptitude to harvest by top lifting and bunching
 - o Very up-right habit, rather short
 - o Healthy foliage and strong attachment
- Good tolerance to bolting

ROOT

- Cylindrical shape, well-rounded tips at maturity
- Average length: 7 – 8" (18 – 20)
- Average diameter: 1.25" - 1.6" (3 – 4 cm)
- Uniform size and shape
- Smooth
- Early coloration

The root size (length and diameter) depends on the sowing population.

EARLINESS

- About 100 days from sowing

OTHER

- IR: *Alternaria Daucy*, Cavity Spot
