Main Season- Nantes Type

- Very uniform, good potential for production of baby Nantes
- Good tolerance to mechanical shocks



DESCRIPTION

PLANT

- Healthy and up-right
- Strong attachment, good aptitude to harvest by top lifting

ROOT

- Very uniform size and shape
- Average size at high population
 - o Average length: 7.5" – 8.5" (19 – 21)
 - o Average diameter: 1.5"- 1.75" (4 – 4.5 cm)
- Very smooth without lenticels
- Well buried in soil, good tolerance to first frost
- Good storage aptitude in soil and in cold room
- High tolerance to mechanical shocks (less breakage and less splitting)

The root size (length and diameter) depends on the sowing population.

EARLINESS

- About 120-130 days from sowing

OTHER

- IR: Alternaria, Powdery Mildew

HR: High Resistance - IR: Intermediate Resistance. The genetic resistances are not dispensed from Vilmorin.
