FOLIAGE

- Strong tops, good disease resistances,
- Good aptitude to harvest by top lifting,

ROOT

- Very smooth,
- Cylindrical shouldered shape,
- Well rounded tips at maturity,
- Average length: 8" - 9" (20-22 cm),
- Average diameter: 1"1/2 – 1"3/4 (4 – 4.5 cm),
- Good internal and external color with a small core, no green shoulders,

The root size (length and diameter) depends on the sowing population.

RESISTANCES

- HR: Alternaria, powdery mildew,
- IR: Cavity spot, Aster yellow (mycoplasma)

Versatile variety, suits well for the organic production.
