- Cherry tomato for greenhouses, well adapted for production on vine
- Excellent fruit quality
- High production potential
- Good resistance to virus



DESCRIPTION

PLANT

- Indeterminate, vigorous with good leaf coverage
- Good fruit setting, very good yield potential
- Healthy foliage with good tolerance to leaf diseases
- Excellent cluster structure; fish bone shape

FRUIT

- Round fruit shape
- Average weight: 15 grams
- Excellent fruit quality:
 - ✓ Good flavor, average brix of 7
 - ✓ No cracking and no Blossom End Rot
 - ✓ Good red and glossy color

OTHER

- HR: ToMV, Fol: 1, 2 ; TSWV
- IR: M, TYLCV
- *For cherry on the vine production, we recommend clusters to be pruned at 12 or 14 fruits*
