Yellow Witloof Chicory

- Heads have a nice commercial presentation and shelf life
- Strong production potential

DESCRIPTION

PLANT

- Upright habit
- Medium length foliage
- Good tolerance to bacterial disease (Erwinia)

WITLOOF

- Rather large head size with a cylindrical shape
- Well finished, 1/2 rounded at the top
- Well and nicely colored with glossy leaves

EARLINESS

- Field: Mid-late (maturity after 160 days) in northern France
- Forcing: Possible beginning in February

OTHER

- High yield of roots from field
- High yield of heads from forcing room
- Not susceptible to brown core (brown axe)

RECOMMENDATIONS:

In field, the plant vigor is quite strong so it is recommended to increase the plant population in order to reduce the root diameter.

In the forcing room, it is also recommended to keep some open space in the forcing containers to let the heads to reach their potential size. If not enough space the heads are very tight to each other.

HR : High Resistance - IR : Intermediate Resistance. The genetic resistances are not dispensed from prophylactic measures to be used as an addition.
