Yellow Witloof Chicory

- **Tolerance to Safari / Cursus herbicides**
- **Early to normal forcing**

DESCRIPTION

PLANT

- Upright to mid-upright habit
- Medium foliage (length)
- Very few dented leaves
- Medium green
- Good root vigor

WITLOOF

- Standard length for this segment
- Cylindrical shape, mid-pointed head, well covered, dense
- Nice colored, bright, and thick leaves
- High uniformity

EARLINESS

- Field: Early to mid-early (after 140 days)
- Forcing: Mainly from October to January (in Europe)

OTHER

- High quality harvest, longer chicory than Manoline
- Very good shelf life
