Yellow Witloof Chicory

- **Tolerance to Safari / Cursus herbicides**
- **Early to normal forcing**

DESCRIPTION

PLANT

- Upright habit
- More vigor than Flexine
- Wide leaves, dented and dark green color

WITLOOF

- Relatively triangular
- Well covered, mid-dense, and pointed
- Good yellow color with wide leaves

EARLINESS

- Field: Around 170 days (northern Europe)
- Forcing: from spring to autumn

OTHER

- High amount of forcing roots
- High % of good quality witloof
- Tolerant to brown core
- Good shelf life after harvesting

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Forcing: not before April, late genetics. Avoid excess of CaCl₂ on roots and buds
