Yellow Witloof Chicory

- Early variety (short growing cycle in field for early forcing)
- Good head quality and nice commercial presentation
- CMS

DESCRIPTION

PLANT

- Vigorous plant: strong leaves with an erected habit
- Rather light green leaves
- Vigorous roots (need to adapt the population density)

WITLOOF

- Standard length, rather cylindrical shape with medium rounded tip
- Well covered tip, dense and heavy (thick and wrapping leaves)
- Nice glossy color

EARLINESS

- Field: Early, growing time about 130 – 140 days in northern France. (with direct sowing and from sowing to root harvest)
- Forcing: Early period, from September to December

OTHER

- High % of great quality heads
- Not prone to brown axe, tip burn and reddish leaves

RECOMMENDATIONS:

If fertile soil, it is necessary to increase the plant population by sqm to reduce the root size.
