- High Production
- Great Quality
- Forcing mid-late to late segment



DESCRIPTION

PLANT

- Mid-upright habit
- Medium vigor
- Green color
- Smooth and cylindrical shape root

WITLOOF

- Cylindrical shape, quite long
- Well covered, dense, pointed
- Yellow color, smooth and thick leaves
- Very uniform

EARLINESS

- In the field, maturity about 170 days after sowing (northern Europe)
- Forcing: Mainly from spring to autumn

OTHER

- High production of forcing roots
- High % of heads with great quality
- Good shelf life

TECHNICAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- Avoid CaCl₂ on the roots and after root plantation in the forcing containers.
